**SPEAKING ORDER**

**READ :** The suspension order no HLA 290/2019/69 dtd 12/07/2019.

**FINDINGS:** Whereas, Dr. Avijit Basu was alleged upon misuse of official power, dereliction of duty and indulgence in activities to the nature which is not accepted to his rank;

Whereas Dr. Avijit Basu was placed under suspension vide order no. HLA 290/2019/69 dtd 11/07/2019 and was asked to submit showcause reply against the charges vide order no. HLA 290/2019/80 dated 01/02/2019. Accordingly, Dr. Avijit Basu submitted show cause reply on 07/11/2019 wherein he denied the charges and the Government was not satisfied with the show cause reply;

Whereas Departmental Proceeding was initiated against him vide order no. HLA 290/2019/75 dated 04/10/2019 by appointing IO and PO to enquire into the charges;

Whereas Dr. Avijit Basu was granted 75% subsistence allowance vide order no HLA 290/2019/103 dated 01/02/2020;

Whereas, IO has submitted detailed Inquiry report on 24/02/2020 wherein the IO found that the charges leveled against Dr. Avijit Basu are proved;

**ORDERS :** In view of above, as the charges of corruption are true, strict action should be taken against the officer concerned. However, given the present situation due to COVID-19 pandemic, we are in need of manpower at appropriate levels to deliver services to the citizens. **We may, therefore, impose a penalty of stopping of two increments with cumulative effect on the erring officer and reinstate him with transfer and posting in another district. The subsistence allowance received by him during suspension period may be treated as full and final and the period of suspension should not be counted for pensionary purposes only.**
