Job Responsibilities:

- 1. Facilitate capacity building of laboratory technicians (LT) by periodically assessing the trainingneeds.
- 2. Perform all laboratory investigations of diseases of Public Health importance with specialreference to diseases under IDSP.
- 3. Guide technicians for laboratory investigations of diseases of Public Health importance withspecial reference to diseases under IDSP.
- 4. Ensure implementation of Standard Operating Procedures (SOP) for laboratory techniquesdeveloped by IDSP
- 5. Ensure implementation of guidelines for Biomedical Waste Management based on existing rules.
- 6. Prepare and submit monthly status report of District Integrated Public Health Laboratory (DIPHL) on laboratory tests carried out to SSU and CSU or any other designated reporting authority.
- 7. Participate in outbreak investigations as member of Rapid Response Team
- 8. Implementation of Internal Quality Assurance of laboratories and ensure participation in ExternalQuality Assurance Programme.
- 9. Assist in procurement of laboratory consumable items and maintenance of laboratory Equipmentincluding calibration of equipment like micropipettes.
